



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9/17/20: Stop AAPI Hate Youth Report

- 341 of 2500 self-reported hate incidents involved AAPI youth nationally (16%)
 - >50% involved anti-Chinese hate speech
 - 24 (7%) involved physical assault
 - Although adults were present in 48% of the cases, bystanders intervened in only 10%








Long history of anti-Asian discrimination in U.S.

- "Uncivilized, unclean, filthy beyond all conception." (New York Daily Tribune, 1854)
- Associated with vice and disease; "Yellow Peril"
- Anti-Asian immigration restrictions:
 - Chinese Exclusion Act (1882)
 - Immigration Act (1917)
 - Johnson–Reed Act (1924)





Coronavirus fears show how 'model minority' Asian Americans become the 'yellow peril'

While viruses and other pathogens do not discriminate between hosts based on race, ethnicity, nationality or immigration status – stigma and misinformation certainly do.













Racism is bad for health and mental health

- Japanese internment, 9/11
- Decreased well-being, life satisfaction, and self esteem; increased anxiety, depression, and suicidal ideation
- Increased cardiac disease, respiratory conditions, pain, disability, and allcause mortality



Hate crimes and negative biases during COVID-19


- Normalization of violence and dehumanization of AA

- Surge in slurs on Twitter since late Jan 2020 (Chen et al., 2020), "Wuhan Virus," "China Virus," and "Kung Flu"


























COVID-19 Adult Resilience Experiences Study (CARES)

- Total of 212 Asians and Asian Americans



Fearful and **Traumatic Events** Among Asian **Americans**

"My dad sent me a text about an Asian woman who got acid thrown at her and tells me to be careful. I tell him I live in a predominantly Asian neighborhood so it's ok, but in reality, I'm scared.... We live in fear."


"I haven't faced discrimination, but I also haven't left the house in close to for 4 weeks....In fact, I fear leaving the house because I have heard reports of multiple attacks in and around my neighborhood."












Types of COVID-19 Anti-Asian discrimination

"My youngest cousins are 2 and 5 years old and have been kicked out of their preschool because of their race."







CONVERSATIONS HELP

PARENTS ARE ESSENTIAL

It's okay if you don't know all the answers, you don't know what to say, or even if you're scared you may traumatize your child by talking about racism.

Self-Esteem School Engagement Family Cohesion

Listening and validating your child's feelings and experiences are important ways to help build resilience. Plus, nobody is ever done learning, so maybe you can figure things out together!

create opportunities for your child to talk

A REMINDER...

DON'T REACT DON'T JUDGE

Keep your face neutral/calm

Don't tell kids and teens what they should or shouldn't feel

JUST LISTEN

IDEAS TO START THE CONVERSATION

Do you feel safe at school? What will help make you feel safe?



Have you felt angry about how Asians are treated and didn't know what to do with it?

Have you ever experienced anyone call you a name or a slur like "Lingling*"?

Do you worry about being looked at differently because you're Asian?

*Lingling is a derogatory word used in high schools and on tiktok towards all Asian groups.

Guide for Parents: Takeaways

- Not talking about racism is more psychologically and emotionally harmful to your children than talking about it.
- It's ok if you don't know as long as you stay open and curious.
- Listen, Listen, Listen.
- You don't need to problem solve.
- Parents are essential in their child's social emotional development. YOU MATTER.
